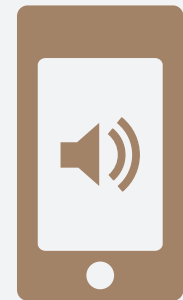

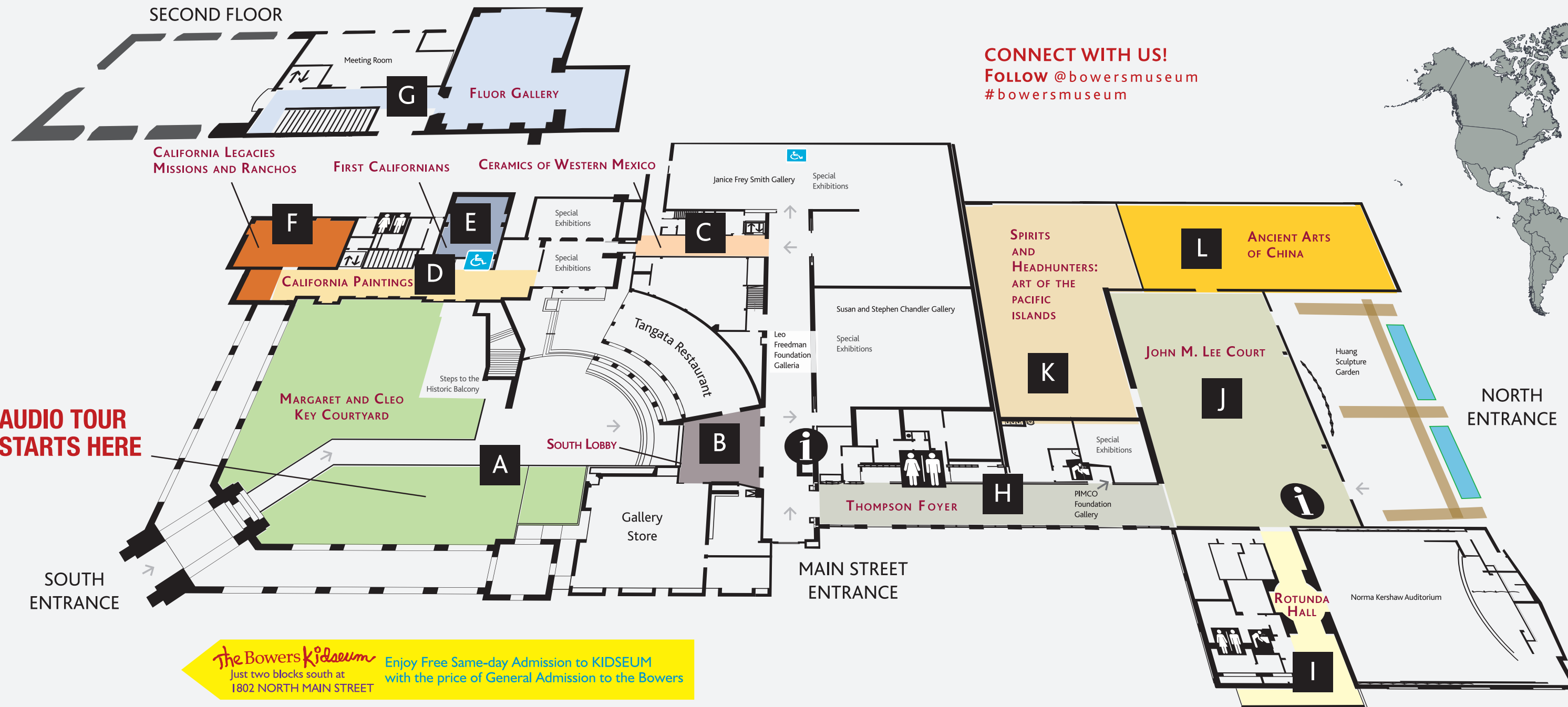

- Service animals are welcome at the Bowers. Please check in at the Visitor Services desk.
- Assisted listening devices are available for programs held in the Kershaw Auditorium.
